Who we are

The Pyramid at Anderston is a community anchor organisation based in the heart of Glasgow, with a long history of hosting memorable events of all shapes and sizes. From weddings and exhibitions to conferences and large-scale creative gatherings, we do it all within our gorgeous B-listed building under the iconic Pyramid-shaped roof!

The Pyramid Design Market is a curated art and design market celebrating unique, well-made work and the brilliant people behind it. We're looking for artists and makers of all backgrounds, with a focus on showcasing local talent and thoughtful pieces. As a brand-new market, we're excited to work closely with artists and makers to shape something special together!


The Pyramid is well-supported by visitors and our local community in Anderston, Finnieston and beyond, and previous Pyramid events have attracted hundreds of people. In recent years, we've become a go-to hub for arts and culture, hosting standout events including INTL Poster Exhibition, SPOT Design Markets, and Glasgow Print Fair. **In 2025, the Print Fair welcomed over 2,000 visitors through our doors in a single day!**

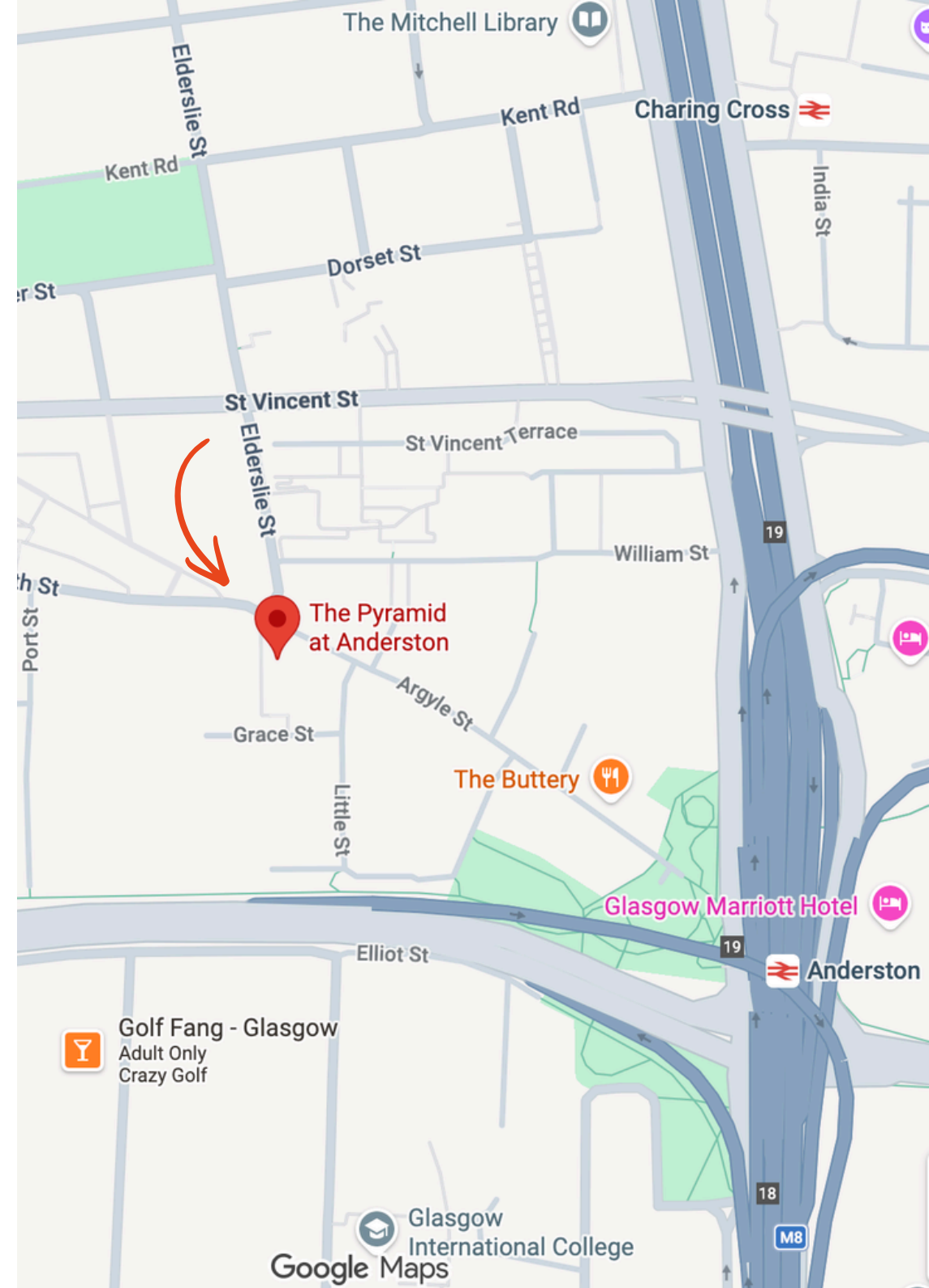

The Pyramid at Anderston is easy to get to. We're walkable from the city centre and west end, with excellent public transport links, and free on street parking at weekends. We encourage you to walk, wheel, cycle or use public transport if possible.

There is paid on street parking. This is limited to 3 hours during the week, but is free after 6pm and at weekends, and on street parking is the most practical for people with limited mobility as it's closer to the front door.



Applications, Selection, and Payment

Please note that this is a curated market, and not all applicants will be successful. We will carefully review applications to ensure a varied and balanced range of sellers. We select sellers to ensure a diverse, high-quality mix that champions local makers and designers.

We encourage sellers from all backgrounds to apply and are keen to support a wide and inclusive community of creatives. If there's anything we can do to remove barriers to your participation, we invite you to tell us in your application.

What your £48 (inc. VAT) table fee covers:

- A vendor spot and trestle table in our market hall
- Multi-channel promotion from The Pyramid including web, print and social media, shareable digital assets, and support from our communication coordinator
- A dedicated Pyramid team member on site throughout the day for support and advice





Table Setup

All tables are 6-foot trestle tables. You are welcome to customise your table as much as you like, with table covers, signage, display boxes and stands, etc. If you would like some extra floor space for a clothes rail or print rack, please let us know in your application and we will do our best to accommodate.

Make yourself easy to spot – bring signage with your name and socials! Business cards or a handy QR code are great for helping visitors find you again beyond the day. And please bring bags or wrapping to send your creations home safely with their new owners.

All tables will be in our Pyramid Hall; a large and bright space filled with lots of the building's original 1968 features. This hall isn't heated, but in summer it's usually very cool and comfortable. That said, temperatures can vary, so we suggest packing an extra layer to stay cosy.

We encourage sellers to apply for tables individually, but if you would prefer to share a table, please include all participating artists' names and info in your application.

Accessibility

The building has step-free access. The market will take place in the Pyramid Hall on the upper floor, which is accessible via platform lift, and there is one accessible toilet on this floor. There are two more accessible toilets in the main toilet block on the ground floor, one of which is a full changing places toilet with a hoist.

Food and Drink

We're planning to invite one or two food and drink vendors to join us on the day. These will be located in a separate space outside the main market hall, serving snacks and drinks to keep everyone fuelled. We'll share more details about food vendors closer to the event.

All market stallholders are also very welcome to bring their own lunch and refreshments. If you fancy stepping out, there are several great cafes nearby on Elderslie Street, as well as plenty of options along Argyle Street in Finnieston.

Drinking water is always readily available at our bottle filling station inside the foyer at The Pyramid!

Market promotion is on us – we'll share the event through digital marketing and a dedicated page on our website, alongside locally distributed posters and flyers.

Each vendor will get a social spotlight using images from your application (and we may ask for more). We'll also supply branded assets to help you spread the word in the lead-up to market day, and you'll have direct support from The Pyramid's communications coordinator.

Insurance requirement

All vendors must have their own Public Liability Insurance. We may request proof of insurance ahead of the event. You may also wish to have insurance to cover your stock or equipment against damage, loss or theft, but this is not a requirement for the event.

Handling payments

Vendors are responsible for managing their own payments. You're welcome to accept payment in whatever way suits you. All vendors will have access to fast Wi-Fi free of charge throughout the day. If you plan to take cash, please remember to bring your own float for change. The Pyramid does not take commission on any sales.

Terms and Conditions

Please be aware that we can't offer refunds on table fees. By applying for our market, artists confirm that they have read, understood and agreed to the terms and conditions provided to them.
